


- Assure there is ample rotation space available for the front cover when mounting.

 Depending on the material quality and thickness of installation surface and volume, the product may resonate and cause an oscillating sound.


5. Wiring

3. Part Names


Outside Appearance [Unit: mm]



4. Installation

Please follow the guidelines to this procedure.

- ① Please mount on a flat surface with a panel thickness of 1 mm to 10 mm with enough space for properly clamping the bracket onto. (Refer to the "Panel-mount Dimension drawing")
- ② Insert (a) products from before a clamp face, and hook attachment lug of (b) accessories on the hole of a product side face. Please bolt the screw thread of (c) attachment lug. (Recommendation bolting torque: 0.7 N-m)
- ③ Check that the product and clamps have been properly tightened before placing the front cover back on.



⚠ WARNING

- The power supply should be turned off prior to attachment at any cost. Failure to comply may result in electric shock.
- Request the installation and wiring be performed by a professional contractor. There is a risk of an electric shock, fire, or falling.


